FDOT to Open Additional Lanes on I-95 at the I-295 North Interchange Monday, New Phase of Construction to Begin

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – FDOT will add additional capacity to I-95 on Monday, May 20 as part of the I-95/I-295 North Interchange reconfiguration. Two new lanes will open on I-95 between Cole Road and just north of Broward River. Due to the nature of the work, the schedule is subject to weather. Should the work need to be rescheduled, crews will open the lanes as soon as possible.

As part of the milestone, I-95 will feature six northbound lanes and five southbound lanes through the interchange, a dedicated lane for motorists heading south on I-95 from Airport Road and accessing the I-295 eastbound flyover, as well as multiple exit ramps and on-ramps to support mobility through the interchange. The additional lanes are expected to improve efficiency and enhance safety by reducing weaving.

This work is part of a new phase of construction on the I-95/I-295 North Interchange Operational Improvements project. FDOT recently added additional safety improvements to the project, including LED lighting and other improvements that were not a part of the original contract. Due to the additional work added to the project, the contractor is expected to complete work in spring 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Adding these features to the project while the contractor is deployed in the field will enhance safety and save taxpayer dollars through a high-efficiency, low maintenance interstate lighting system.

Archer Western was awarded the \$176.8 million project. The project is expected to be completed in spring 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
