### Main Street Bridge to See Detour Sunday

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Main Street Bridge will be closed on Sunday, May 5 for routine bridge maintenance. Both directions of the bridge will be closed to drivers and pedestrians. The closure will take place from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Drivers will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge; marine traffic will not be impacted by the closures.

The Florida Department of Transportation has a robust bridge maintenance program that protects taxpayer investments and ensures the structures receive preventative maintenance to extend the life of their investment.

The Main Street Bridge is a vertical lift bridge and is raised and lowered more than 1,400 times a year.
