New Traffic Pattern Scheduled to Begin May 13 on State Road 16 at I-95

Newly constructed lanes on State Road 16 westbound at I-95 will open to traffic

ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla. – A new traffic pattern on westbound State Road 16 approaching I-95 is scheduled to begin Monday, May 13 at 6 a.m.

- Traffic on westbound State Road 16 approaching I-95 will shift north to use the newly-constructed lanes.
- The slip lane on the I-95 North on-ramp from State Road 16 will reopen.
- The slip lane on the State Road 16 exit ramp from I-95 South will reopen.

Motorists are encouraged to use caution in the area during this time as drivers get used to the new traffic pattern.

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$31 million resurfacing improvements by early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
