PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a roadway improvement project in Fall 2017 at the San Marco Avenue (S.R. A1A/S.R. 5A), May Street (S.R. A1A) and West San Carlos Avenue intersection in St. Augustine. The roadway will be reconfigured and widened to allow for better traffic flow in the area. Additional work also includes pedestrian and traffic signals, shared bicycle lanes and drainage improvements on May Street from east of San Marco Avenue to the Hospital Creek Bridge. Drainage improvements on May Street are expected to begin once the intersection reconstruction is completed.
