FDOT looked at location and pulled crash data




Project Overview

- At north of Reba Avenue
- At south of Putnam Avenue
- Several crashes and one pedestrian fatality reported
- Area meets signal warrant criteria
- No current crosswalks available

Proposed Improvements

Construct partial signalized RCUT at both intersections


Crosswalks will be added to both intersections

- Northbound Philips Highway will have signalized left lane and U-Turn movements onto Reba Avenue
- Southbound Philips Highway will have signalized left lane and U-Turn movements onto Putnam Avenue
 - No U-Turns will be allowed for trucks
