

Arlington Expressway Sidewalk Project

Arlington Expressway from Arlington Road to Arlingwood Avenue

Project information:

The Florida Department of Transportation is constructing and upgrading sidewalks along the Arlington Expressway North Service Road from Arlington Road to Arlingwood Avenue. This project is scheduled to begin in late August, but could begin sooner. In addition, intersections and sidewalks will be upgraded on the Cesery Boulevard and Arlington Road bridges over the Arlington Expressway.

J.B. Coxwell Contracting was hired by FDOT to complete this \$2.8 million project by Summer 2020, barring unforeseen circumstances such as bad weather.

Traffic impacts:

Construction along the corridor will take place close to the roadway and drivers should expect lane closures.

On Arlington Expressway North Service Road from Arlingwood Avenue to Arlington Road, one lane will be closed for several months; westbound traffic will remain open and eastbound traffic will be closed and detoured (see reverse side for map). JTA bus stop locations will remain in service but may be temporarily shifted to accommodate construction activities. Pedestrians are encouraged to follow the alternate route provided.

On Arlington Expressway under the bridges of Arlington Road and Cesery Boulevard, lane closures are anticipated Monday through Sunday from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

On Cesery Boulevard and Arlington Road across Arlington Expressway, minor lane shifts and lane width reductions will be in place.

As part of the project, crews will construct sidewalks, driveways, guardrail, handrail and intersection/ bridge improvements. This project will improve mobility and access for pedestrians along the corridor.

Construction schedule, lane closures and detours are dependent on weather and other unforeseen circumstances.
