
Queens Harbor Traffic Signal Project

Queens Harbor Boulevard and Atlantic Boulevard



The Florida Department of Transportation will be making improvements to the traffic signal at the intersection of Queens Harbor Boulevard and Atlantic Boulevard. These improvements will consist of new vehicular and pedestrian signals, crosswalks, signage and enhanced lighting.

Drivers should expect routine lane closures to allow crews to complete the work. No lane closures will be permitted from 6:30 a.m. to 10 p.m. daily.

As part of the project, crews will complete curb and gutter, install new highway sign lighting, update sidewalks, new street guide signage and complete other incidental construction within the project area.

This project will improve the flow of traffic and promote safety for pedestrians.
