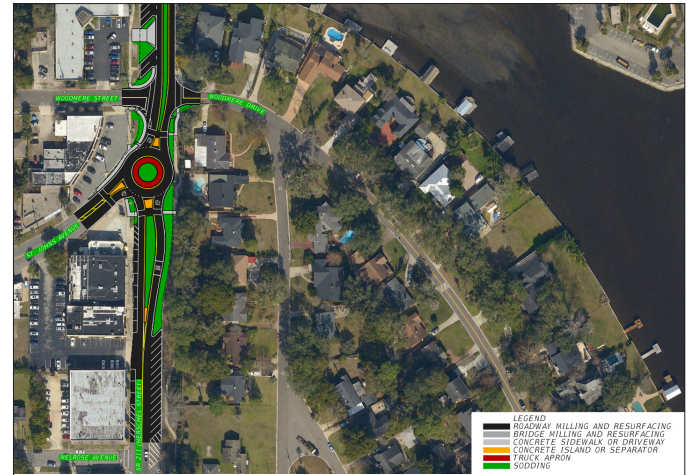
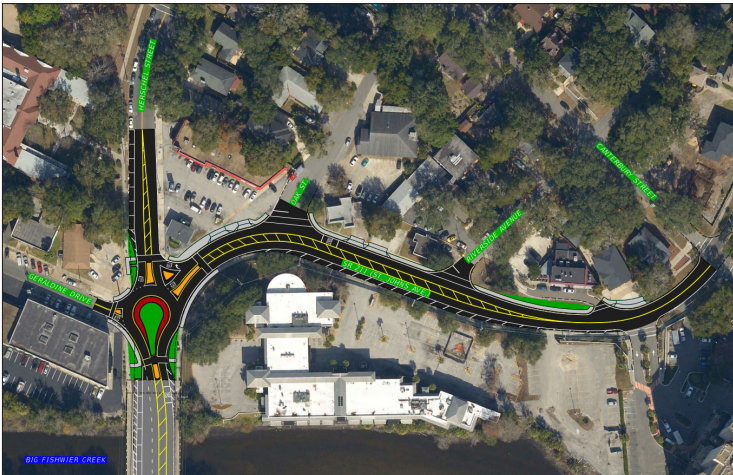


ACCESS MANAGEMENT HEARING



ABOUT THE PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation is considering changes to the roadway, striping and medians on State Road 211 (St. Johns Avenue/Herschel Street) between Canterbury Street and Melrose Avenue.

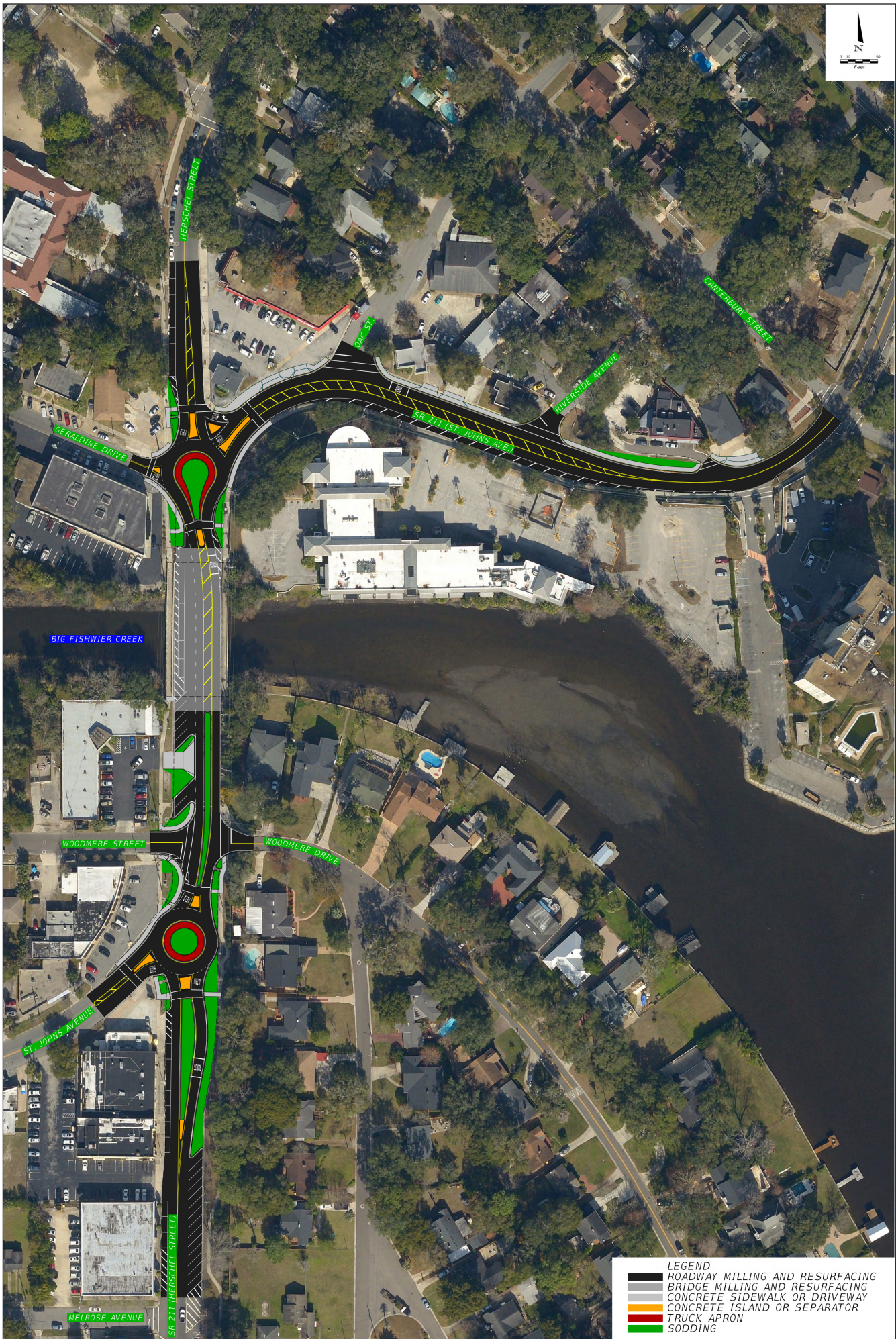
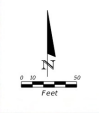
The project proposes the following changes to reduce confusion through the intersections and improve pedestrian safety:

- Reconfiguring the roadway to replace two signalized intersections with single-lane roundabouts
- Adding sidewalk along the north side of St. Johns Avenue from Herschel Street to Canterbury Street
- Adding additional pedestrian crosswalks and pedestrian refuge islands to reduce the exposure distance for pedestrians crossing the road
