FDOT staff and consultants will be available from 4 to 6 p.m. to answer questions and accept comments. A formal hearing and public comment period will begin at 6 p.m. **Presentations, project-related material and the opportunity to speak, submit comments and questions will be the same whether participants attend online or in person.** 

## **ABOUT THE PROJECT**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes closing a portion of the median on San Juan Avenue (State Road 128) in order to complete work on a Mid-Block Pedestrian Crossing with a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) near the Noble House Assisted Living Facility. A 2017 FDOT traffic study concluded this is an area with high pedestrian traffic and a mid-block crossing was recommended to improve pedestrian safety.
