

Rise: A Real Estate Co. plans to build a 260-unit apartment community on 8.98 acres at 12375, 12387 and 12421 San Jose Boulevard. In order to maintain safe and efficient traffic flow at the location, FDOT proposes converting the existing full median opening at San Jose Boulevard and Mandarin Meadows Drive into a directional median opening. If approved, construction on the median modifications is expected to begin in May 2020.

To provide citizens with an opportunity to share input on the proposed changes, FDOT will host a hybrid public hearing **Thursday**, **December 10**, online at nflroads.com/VPH or by phone at (415) 655-0052, access code 821-654-882. Citizens who are unable to participate virtually or by phone may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. An informal open house will be held from 4:30 to 6 p.m., during which attendees may ask questions and discuss the project with members of the project team. A formal public comment period will begin at 6 p.m.

Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons who wish to submit written statements or other exhibits may do so prior to or during the hearing in the comments section at nflroads.com/VPH. Citizens may also submit questions, statements and other exhibits by sending them to Julian McKinley P.E., Maintenance Program Engineer, via email at julian.mckinley@dot.state.fl.us or traditional mail at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before December 20, 2020 will become part of the public hearing record. Project-related documents are currently available for review at nflroads.com/VPH.
