

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is considering changes to Timuquana Road (State Road 134) that would close the median at Water Oak Lane as part of an upcoming resurfacing project. The proposed project design has been updated to retain on-street parking from Water Oak Lane to the Ortega River Bridge.

To provide citizens with an opportunity to share input on the proposed changes, FDOT will host a hybrid public hearing **Thursday, March 25**, online at nflroads.com/VPH or by phone at (562) 247-8321, access code 586-531-094. Citizens who are unable to participate virtually or by phone may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. During the open house from 4 to 6 p.m., attendees may ask questions and discuss the project with the project team. A formal public comment period will begin at 6 p.m.

Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons who wish to submit written statements or other exhibits may do so prior to or during the hearing in the comments section at nflroads.com/VPH. Citizens may also submit questions, statements and other exhibits by sending them to Wayne Tooker Jr., MPM, Project Manager, via email at Wayne.TookerJr@dot.state.fl.us or traditional mail at 1109 S. Marion Avenue, Lake City, FL 32025. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before April 4, 2021 will become part of the public hearing record.
