

Project Purpose

The Florida Department of Transportation is proposing to extend State Road 312 in St. Johns County (this extension was formerly known as State Road 313):

- This project will provide a two-lane roadway connection between the existing State Road 207 intersection and South Holmes Boulevard.
- The Department's long-term plan is to further extend State Road 312 to State Road 16 and ultimately to U.S. 1 near the airport.
