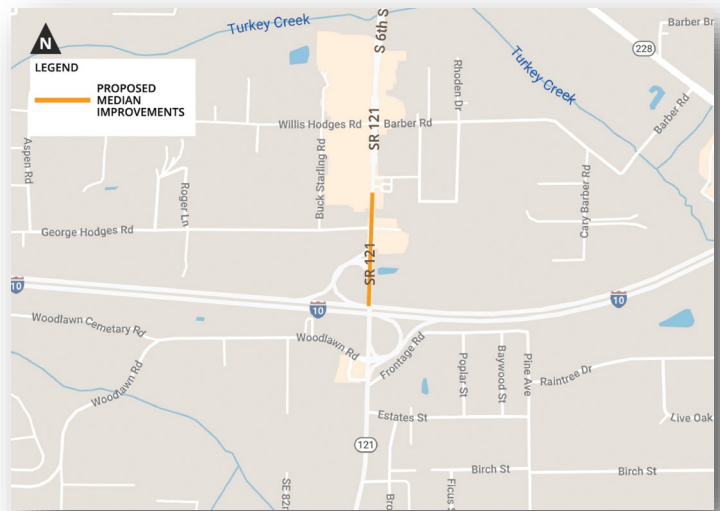

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) welcomes you to the SR-121 Access Management Public Meeting .

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The FDOT is proposing an access management change at the intersection of SR-121 and George Hodges Road by replacing the full median opening to a directional median opening. This feature would restrict movements directly across SR-121 on George Hodges Road, instead, requiring a right turn movement from George Hodges Road onto SR-121.

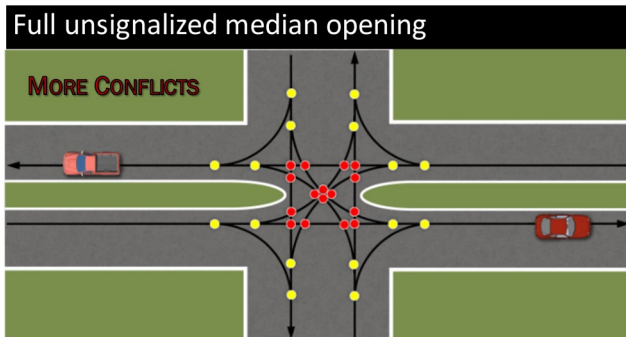

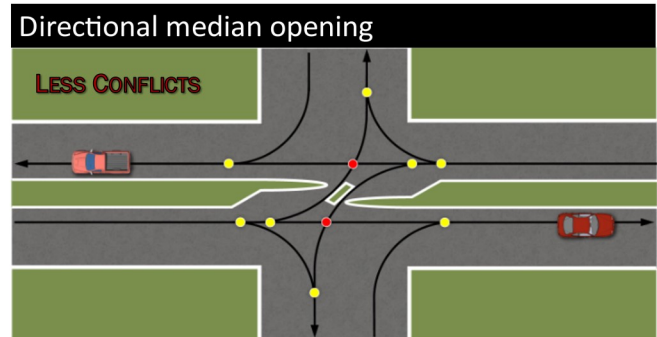
How Does Access Management Improve Safety?

Access management improves safety by reducing the number of potential conflict points by users of the transportation network.

The proposed directional median feature would reduce the number of conflict points at this intersection, lessening the opportunity for crashes.

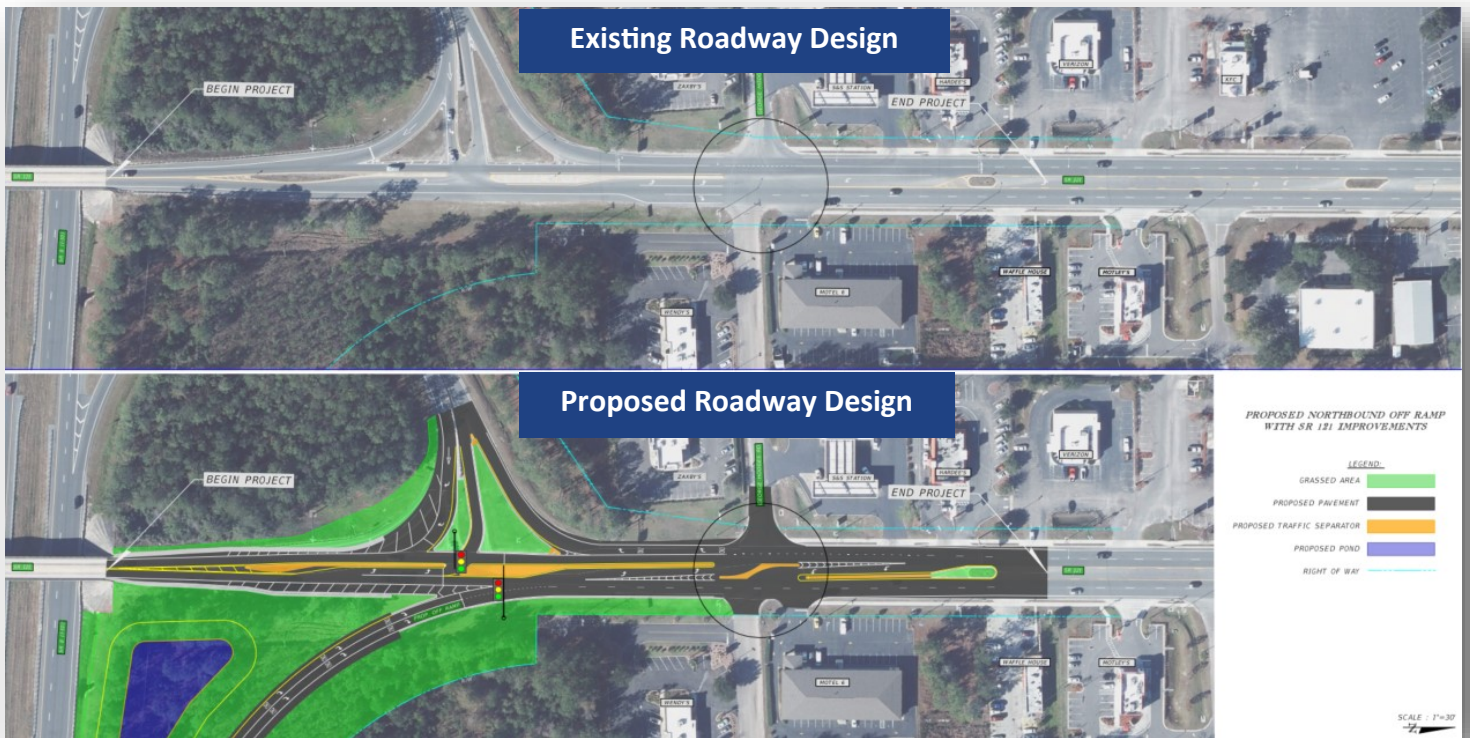


● Red are crossing conflict points
