Proposed Roadway Improvements

Construct intersection improvements at CR 209 (Russell Road) that include replacing the existing traffic signal, adding directional islands in the median, adding a new signal at Mahama Bluff Road, lengthening the northbound left turn lane on U.S. 17, and enhancing roadway lighting. The improvements will coincide with Clay County's CR 209 (Russell Road) widening project, which is currently in the initial construction phase.



Proposed Roadway Improvements

Modify the existing median opening at Biovin Road and CR 209. The existing full median opening will be converted to a directional median opening allowing for southbound to eastbound turn movements from U.S. 17 to CR 209. The proposed changes were designed alongside Clay County to help traffic flow on U.S. 17.
