The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) proposes installation of a cul-de-sac where Indigo Drive currently connects to Emerson Street. This change will mitigate a sight distance issue associated with the JEA lift station located at the southwest corner of the Emerson Street/Indigo Drive intersection. Construction of the cul-de-sac is expected to begin in 2024.

To provide the public with an opportunity to share input on the proposed change, FDOT will host a hybrid public meeting **Monday**, **Nov. 6**, **2023**, online at nflroads.com/VPH or by phone at (562) 247-8422, access code 464-904-901. Interested parties who are unable to participate virtually or by phone may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. An informal open house will be held from 5 to 6 p.m., during which attendees may ask questions and discuss the project with members of the project team. A formal presentation and public comment period will begin at 6 p.m.

Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. Persons who wish to submit written statements or other exhibits may do so prior to or during the hearing in the comments section at nflroads.com/VPH. Interested parties may also submit questions, statements and other exhibits to Will Lyons, Project Manager, via email at Will.Lyons@dot.state.fl.us or traditional mail at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. All exhibits or statements postmarked on or before Nov. 16, 2023 will become part of the public hearing record. Project-related documents are available for review at nflroads.com/VPH.
