


ABOUT THE PROJECT

This portion of SR A1A has a large number of pedestrians and bicyclists. Approximately 14,000 vehicles use this stretch of the road daily. Currently, there is a 5-foot sidewalk on the north side of the roadway along the east-west portion of the corridor from Magnolia Avenue to Coastal Highway. North on SR A1A to Twenty-Fourth Street, there are no pedestrian facilities. Currently, bicyclists use the roadway shoulder.

This project is proposing a trail separated from the roadway that will provide safe access through this area. The trail will provide better access to the Vilano Town Center, numerous parks, beach access points, and the City of St. Augustine.




PROPOSED TYPICAL SECTIONS
