

The purpose of this meeting is to inform the public of the proposed improvements and provide an opportunity for the public to express their opinions and concerns regarding the project.

About the Project

The intersection of Race Track Road and US 1 (Philips Hwy) is experiencing significant congestion during peak hours. A Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study is currently underway to evaluate alternatives to address traffic operations and safety improvements at the intersection of Race Track Road/Nocatee Parkway and US 1 (Philips Hwy). The proposed concept being presented will reduce the delay for motorists traveling through the intersection.

Access management is the careful planning of the location, design and type of access to properties, businesses and homes. This also includes median openings and driveway opening guidelines. Access management serves to promote safe and efficient movement of people and goods by reducing conflict.

How does Access Management improve safety?
