Baymeadows Road and I-95 ramp closures scheduled Friday through Monday to install an overhead roadway sign

Jacksonville – Two inside lanes of westbound and eastbound Baymeadows Road from Western Way to Baymeadows Way, and one left inside turn lane of the I-95 northbound exit ramp to westbound Baymeadows Road will be closed Friday night at 11 p.m. through Monday morning at 7 a.m. (November 3-6) to install an overhead roadway sign. Traffic control officers will be on site to direct traffic.

In addition, the right “free-flow” lane from I-95 southbound to Baymeadows Road westbound will close Sunday night at 11 p.m. and reopen Monday by 7 a.m. (November 5-6).

Drivers should expect significant traffic delays and congestion in the area and are encouraged to use alternate routes, if possible.

The work, weather and schedule permitting, is part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s (FDOT) Baymeadows Road intersection and safety improvement project. The project, along two-miles of Baymeadows Road (State Road 152) from Prominence Parkway to Southside Boulevard includes the addition of right and left turn lanes and five intersections, the closure of a median located 400-feet west of Southside Boulevard, a sidewalk on the south side of Baymeadows Road, traffic signal upgrades and countdown pedestrian timers at crosswalks.

The \$6.6 million project began December 2016 is scheduled for completion in early 2018.
