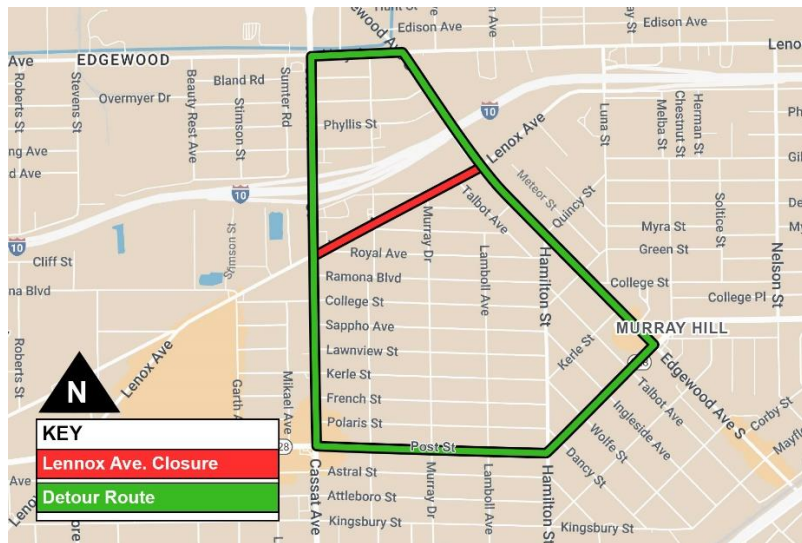

Brief Road Closure on Lenox Avenue Between Cassat Avenue and Edgewood Avenue Jan. 9

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s Edgewood Avenue South from Roosevelt Boulevard to Cassat Avenue Roadway Improvements project, Lenox Avenue will briefly close and traffic detoured between Lenox Avenue and Edgewood Avenue South Wednesday, Jan. 10. The closure will start at 12 p.m. and is expected to reopen at 3 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The roadway closure will take place to allow for the removal of a tree near Murray Street.

Traffic seeking to travel from Edgewood Avenue South to Cassat Avenue should follow detour signs during the closure.



FDOT selected Superior Construction to complete this \$7.66 million project in summer 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
