Buckman Bridge Permanent Joint Rehabilitation to Begin July 9

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Buckman Bridge will see permanent repairs to a damaged finger joint beginning July 9. The permanent repair will take place over six consecutive weekends, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting, to reduce the impact to drivers. Due to the reduced capacity, motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and expect delays during the weekend work.

Crews will implement double lane closures on the bridge beginning at 9 p.m. Friday night until the following Monday at 5 a.m. Two lanes will remain open throughout the duration of the weekend and all lanes will be open during peak hours weekdays.

The Buckman Bridge rehabilitation of the finger joint is expected to be complete in mid-August, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Inspectors will continue to monitor the temporary repair until the rehabilitation is complete.
