FDOT to Host Open House on Possible Changes to County Road 220

Clay County – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public information meeting to discuss proposed improvements to County Road 220 from Shamrock Drive to Knight Boxx Road in Clay County. The open house meeting will be held Thursday, September 28 from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. at HighPoint Community Church, 84 Knight Boxx Road, Orange Park, FL, 32065.

FDOT is conducting a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study to evaluate alternatives to enhance safety and add capacity to meet existing and future traffic needs. Options being considered include widening C.R. 220 to four lanes and the No-Build (do nothing) alternative.

Attendees will have the opportunity to review project-related exhibits and discuss alternatives with FDOT staff. Project materials will also be available for review online at www.nflroads.com/CR220.
