### **Calibration complete, tolls enforced on I-295 Managed Lanes**

*Starting Monday, I-295 Managed Lanes to see toll enforcement, violations*

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) completed calibration of tolling facilities along the I-295 East Beltway Managed Lanes.

Starting Monday, May 23, motorists will see a \$0.50 toll for use of the Managed Lanes during peak hours. Vehicles without a SunPass or interoperable transponder who choose to use the Managed Lanes will face a \$25 toll violation as TOLL-BY-PLATE is not accepted in the Managed Lanes.

The I-295 Managed Lanes are operating in “time of day” tolling, which means tolls will only be charged during peak travel times. Peak travel times along this corridor of I-295 are from **6 a.m. to 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. to 7 p.m. Monday through Friday.**

During non-peak hours, tolls are not collected, and violations for users without a transponder are waived. Motorists who may use the lanes during peak hours are encouraged to obtain a SunPass or another interoperable transponder to avoid the toll violation.
