Chesser Monroe Road at State Road 20 to Close Temporarily to Complete Roadway Widening Work Starting February 16

HAWTHORNE, Fla. – As part of the of widening improvements on State Road 20 from the Putnam County line to SW 56th Avenue, Chesser Monroe Road at State Road 20 will close to traffic Wednesday, February 16 through late April, weather and schedule permitting. The temporary closure is necessary to complete driveway, sidewalk and asphalt paving tie-in work.

Drivers will detour via Baden Powel Avenue to East Washington Avenue to return to Chesser Monroe Road (map below).

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$49 million widening improvements by early 2023. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.


