Construction to Start Next Week on U.S. 1 from Ingham Road to the Georgia State Line Resurfacing Project

HILLIARD, Fla. – Construction is beginning next week on the Florida Department of Transportation's U.S. 1 from Ingham Road to the Georgia State Line resurfacing project.

In addition to milling and resurfacing, the project will include driveway approach improvements, milling and resurfacing of the weigh station, guardrail installation, sidewalk construction and traffic signal and signage updates.

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. No lane closures will be allowed between 6:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m.

Anderson Columbia, Co. was selected to complete this project at a cost of \$12.72 million in late 2024, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
