Daytime Detour Planned for East Cowpen Lake Road at State Road 20 for Drainage Work Starting Tomorrow


HAWTHORNE, Fla. – As part of the widening improvements on State Road 20 from the Putnam County line to SW 56th Avenue, access to East Cowpen Lake Road from State Road 20 will be temporarily closed March 16 through March 23 from 8 a.m. to 6 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Drivers will detour via County Road 21 and State Road 20A (map below).

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$49 million widening improvements by early 2023. Construction schedule and completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.
