Detour of McDuff Avenue to I-10 East On-Ramp Planned for This Weekend

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, the on-ramp from McDuff Avenue to I-10 east will be detoured from Friday, January 28 at 10 p.m. until Sunday, January 30 at 6 p.m., weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Drivers on northbound McDuff Avenue will turn right on Edison Avenue, turn right on Stockton Street and turn left at the I-10 east on-ramp. Drivers on southbound McDuff Avenue will turn left on U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) and continue onto I-10 east.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

January is Move Over month in Florida. FDOT reminds motorists to move over for first responders or service vehicles displaying any visible signals while stopped on the roadside, including Road Rangers, sanitation vehicles and tow trucks.
