Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Sunday, Jan. 28 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Jan. 28 through Friday, Feb. 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• I-10 east exit to McDuff Avenue to close: Drivers will detour to Stockton Street, right on Stockton Street and right on Irene Street to the I-10 west on-ramp to McDuff Avenue.

Closures scheduled Sunday, Jan. 28 through Wednesday, Jan. 31 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- I-10 west exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) to close: Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.
- Luna Street on-ramp to I-10 east to close: Drivers will detour to Rayford Street, straight to McDuff Avenue, and take the I-10 east on-ramp.

Closure scheduled Thursday, Feb. 1 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- McDuff Avenue at I-10 to close: Northbound drivers will detour to I-10 east, take the Stockton Street exit, right on Stockton Street, right on Irene Street and take I-10 west to reconnect with McDuff Avenue. Southbound drivers will detour to I-10 west to the Luna Street exit, left on Luna Street and left on Rayford Street to reconnect with McDuff Avenue.
- McDuff Avenue on-ramp to I-10 east to close: Drivers will detour on Rosselle Street east to Stockton Street, to the I-10 east on-ramp.

Closure scheduled Friday, Feb. 2 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• I-10 west exit to Cassat Avenue to close: Drivers will detour on I-10 to Lane Avenue, right on Lane Avenue, right on Highway Avenue to Cassat Avenue.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
