Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Monday, Feb. 6 through Thursday, Feb. 9 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

<u>I-10 West Exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard):</u> Monday, Feb. 6 through Wednesday, Feb. 8 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will be detoured to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

<u>I-10 East Exit to I-295:</u> Thursday, Feb. 9 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will continue on I-10 east, take the Lane Avenue exit, turn left on Lane Avenue, turn left onto the I-10 west on-ramp and continue to I-295.

McDuff Avenue to I-10 East On-Ramp: Monday, Feb. 6 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., northbound drivers will be detoured to the I-10 westbound on-ramp, exit at Luna Street and take the I-10 eastbound on-ramp. Southbound drivers will continue south on McDuff Avenue and turn left on U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) to connect with I-10 eastbound.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
