Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Friday, March 15 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

Closure scheduled from 10 p.m. Friday, March 15 to 7 p.m. Sunday, March 17:

 Irene Street to I-10 West on-ramp closed: Drivers will detour to Edison Avenue and take Forest Street to connect with I-10 West.

Closure scheduled Sunday, March 17 and Monday, March 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

 I-10 West exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) closed: Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.

Closure scheduled Monday, March 18 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

 Luna Street to I-10 East on-ramp closed: Drivers will detour to Rayford Street to McDuff Avenue connect with I-10 East.

Closure scheduled Tuesday, March 19 to Friday, March 22 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

• I-10 West off-ramp to McDuff Avenue closed: Drivers will detour to Luna Street and Lenox Avenue to connect with McDuff Avenue.

Closure scheduled Friday, March 22 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

 I-10 East off-ramp to McDuff Avenue closed: Drivers will detour to Stockton Street to Irene Street to Edison Avenue to Forest Street and take I-10 west to connect with McDuff Avenue.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
