## Detours Scheduled from Aug. 18 to Aug. 22 as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Sunday, Aug. 18 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Please note that schedules may be adjusted to avoid conflicting detour traffic along the routes.

Closures scheduled Sunday, Aug. 18 and Monday, Aug. 19 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **I-10 West exit to U.S. 17 (Roosevelt Boulevard) closed:** Drivers will detour to the McDuff Avenue exit and turn left on McDuff Avenue to connect with Roosevelt Boulevard.
- **U.S. 17 on-ramp to I-10 East Closed:** Drivers will detour Edgewood Avenue, to Plymouth Street and take McDuff Avenue to connect with I-10 East.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Aug. 18 through Wednesday, Aug. 21 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **Cassat Avenue on-ramp to I-10 West closed:** Northbound drivers will detour to Highway Avenue and take Lane Avenue to connect with I-10 West. Southbound drivers will detour to Lenox Avenue, to Normandy Boulevard and take Lane Avenue to connect with I-10 West.

Closure scheduled Sunday, Aug. 18 through Thursday, Aug. 22 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **McDuff Avenue on-ramp to I-10 East closed:** Drivers will detour to Rosselle Street and take Stockton Street to connect with I-10 East.

Closure scheduled Tuesday, Aug. 20 through Thursday, Aug. 22 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **I-10 West exit to McDuff Avenue closed:** Drivers will detour to Luna Street and take Lenox Avenue to connect with McDuff Avenue.
