Detours Scheduled from Aug. 25 to Aug. 29 as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, closures and detours are scheduled at multiple interchanges within the project limits beginning Sunday, Aug. 25 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. Please note that schedules may be adjusted to avoid conflicting detour traffic along the routes.

Closures scheduled Sunday, Aug. 25 and Monday, Aug. 26 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **Luna Street on-ramp to I-10 East closed:** Drivers will detour to Rayford Street and take McDuff Avenue to connect with I-10 East.
- **I-10 East exit to McDuff Avenue closed:** Drivers will detour to Stockton Street, to Irene Street, to Edison Avenue, to Forest Street and take I-10 West to connect with McDuff Avenue.

Closures scheduled Sunday, Aug. 25 through Thursday, Aug. 29 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **Irene Street on-ramp to I-10 West closed:** Drivers will detour to Edison Avenue and take Forest Street to connect with I-10 West.
- **I-10 West exit to Luna Street closed:** Drivers will detour Cassat Avenue and take Highway Avenue to connect with Luna Street.

Closure scheduled Tuesday, Aug. 27 through Thursday, Aug. 29 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. the following morning:

- **Cassat Avenue on-ramp to I-10 East:** Northbound drivers will detour to Cassat Avenue, to Highway Avenue and take Luna Street to connect with I-10 East. Southbound drivers will detour to Lenox Avenue and take Luna Street to connect with I-10 East.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in summer 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
