Detours Scheduled for Next Week as Part of FDOT's I-10 Widening Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of FDOT's I-10 from I-295 to I-95 widening project, detours are scheduled at interchanges within the project limits from Sunday, Nov. 5 through Thursday, Nov. 9 while crews perform bridge construction operations, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

McDuff Avenue at I-10 closed: Sunday, Nov. 5 through Wednesday, Nov. 8 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., northbound drivers will take I-10 east to Stockton Street, right on Stockton Street, right on Irene Street and take I-10 west to reconnect with McDuff Avenue. Southbound drivers will take I-10 west to the Luna Street exit, left on Luna Street and left on Rayford Avenue to reconnect with McDuff Avenue.

I-10 West Exit to I-295 closed: Wednesday, Nov. 8 and Thursday, Nov. 9 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to the Hammond Boulevard exit, left on Hammond Boulevard and left on Normandy Boulevard to connect with I-295.

I-10 West Off-Ramp to Cassat Avenue closed: Monday, Nov. 6 through Thursday, Nov. 9 from 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., drivers will detour to the Lane Avenue exit, right on Lane Avenue and right on Highway Avenue to connect with Cassat Avenue.

FDOT hired Superior Construction to complete this \$174.5 million project in early 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
