Double-Lane Closures Expected on Eastbound I-10 This Weekend

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – Drivers approaching the First Coast Expressway (SR 23) on eastbound I-10 will see double-lane closures Saturday, June 15 and Sunday, June 16 from 9 am. to 5 p.m. as FDOT staff perform bridge inspections on the overpasses at SR 23 and Halsema Road. The routine inspections are being performed as part of FDOT's Bridge Maintenance Program.

Crews will close the two inside lanes of eastbound I-10. The outside lane will remain open. The closures are necessary for the safety of both bridge inspection staff and drivers.

Motorists traveling on eastbound I-10 should expect delays and plan ahead. Drivers seeking real-time traffic alerts are encouraged to visit www.FL511.com or download the FL511 app prior to their journey.
