### **Drivers to See Temporary Road Closures on State Road 20 in Interlachen This Week**

**Interlachen, Fla.** – As part of the State Road 20 widening project, drivers traveling on State Road 20 will see temporary road closures at Keuka Road, Francis Street and Columbus Avenue starting Thursday, August 20 through mid-October, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The temporary closures are necessary to complete widening and reconstruction work at State Road 20 access points.

Access to State Road 20 at Keuka Road will be temporarily unavailable. Drivers will detour via Vancouver Circle and Istanbul Street (map 1). State Road 20 will not be closed.

Access to State Road 20 at Francis Street and Columbus Avenue will also be temporarily unavailable. Drivers will detour via Boylston Street and Commonwealth Avenue (map 2).

Periodic traffic/lane shifts will be necessary on State Road 20 to allow the contractor to safely complete work. Lane closures are allowed Monday through Friday after 8:30 a.m.

This segment includes widening State Road 20 from SW 56<sup>th</sup> Avenue to County Road 315 from a two-lane roadway to a four-lane urban roadway with curbs, gutters, medians, bike lanes, 5-foot sidewalk on the north side and a 10-foot multi-use path on the south side of the roadway.

P & S Paving, Inc. was selected to complete the \$23 million roadway construction by summer 2021. Construction completion estimates are fluid and subject to change, weather and schedule permitting.

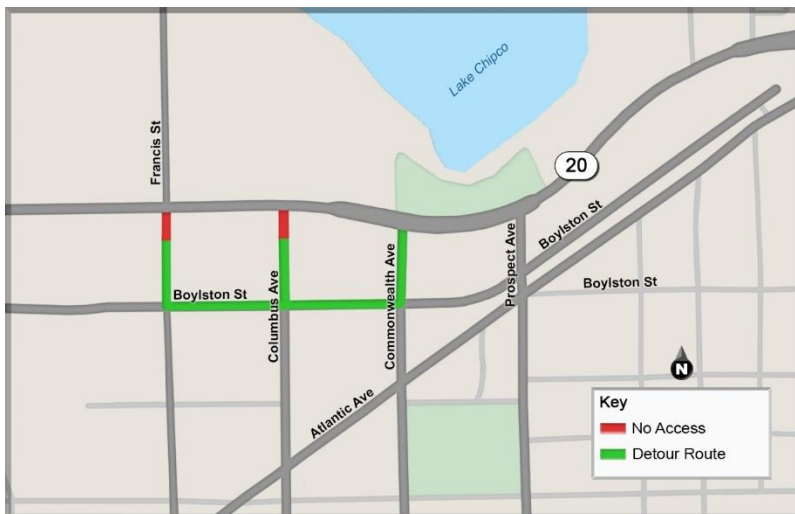
