Eastbound State Road 100 Detoured Overnight on May 24

STARKE, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation's Starke Railroad Overpass Interchange Improvements project, eastbound State Road 100 between U.S. 301 and Water Street will be closed 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. starting Wednesday, May 24, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The backup night for this work is Thursday, May 25.

Eastbound State Road 100 vehicle traffic will turn right onto southbound U.S. 301, then turn left onto SE 144th Avenue (Hazen Street) and continue onto SE 144th Street to State Road 100.

FDOT hired J.B. Coxwell Contracting to complete this \$23.6 million project in late 2023, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
