

FDOT to Activate New Traffic Signal at U.S. 441 and County Road 234 West in Micanopy

GAINESVILLE, Fla. – FDOT will activate new traffic signals at the intersection of U.S. 441 and County Road 234 West in Micanopy the night of Monday, July 11, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting. The safety improvements are part of the U.S. 441 from the Marion County line to Williston Road resurfacing project. Drivers should be prepared to stop and may encounter law enforcement who will be on site to assist with traffic management during the operation.

The new signals will allow for safer left turns from U.S. 441 north onto CR 234 West and safer left turns from CR 234 West onto U.S. 441 north while maintaining a continuous traffic flow for northbound lanes.



FDOT hired Preferred Materials, Inc., to complete the \$13.9 million project by summer 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
