### **FDOT to Host Hybrid Public Hearing for Atlantic Boulevard at Mill Creek Road Median Modification Project**

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation will host a hybrid public hearing Thursday, April 29 from 4 to 6 p.m. to discuss a proposed permit-related median and intersection modification on Atlantic Boulevard (State Road 10) at Mill Creek Road.

To maintain a safe and efficient traffic flow at the intersection, FDOT proposes the developer install a raised concrete median on Atlantic Boulevard at Mill Creek Road to prevent drivers from turning left (east) on Atlantic Boulevard and adding a dedicated right turn lane on Atlantic Boulevard to northbound Mill Creek Road.

Citizens who are unable to participate virtually or by phone may attend the hearing in person at the FDOT Urban Office Training Center located at 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204.

FDOT staff and consultants will be available from 4 to 6 p.m. to answer questions and accept comments. A formal hearing and public comment period will begin at 6 p.m. Citizens are strongly encouraged to use the virtual options for participation. Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements that will become part of the public hearing record. 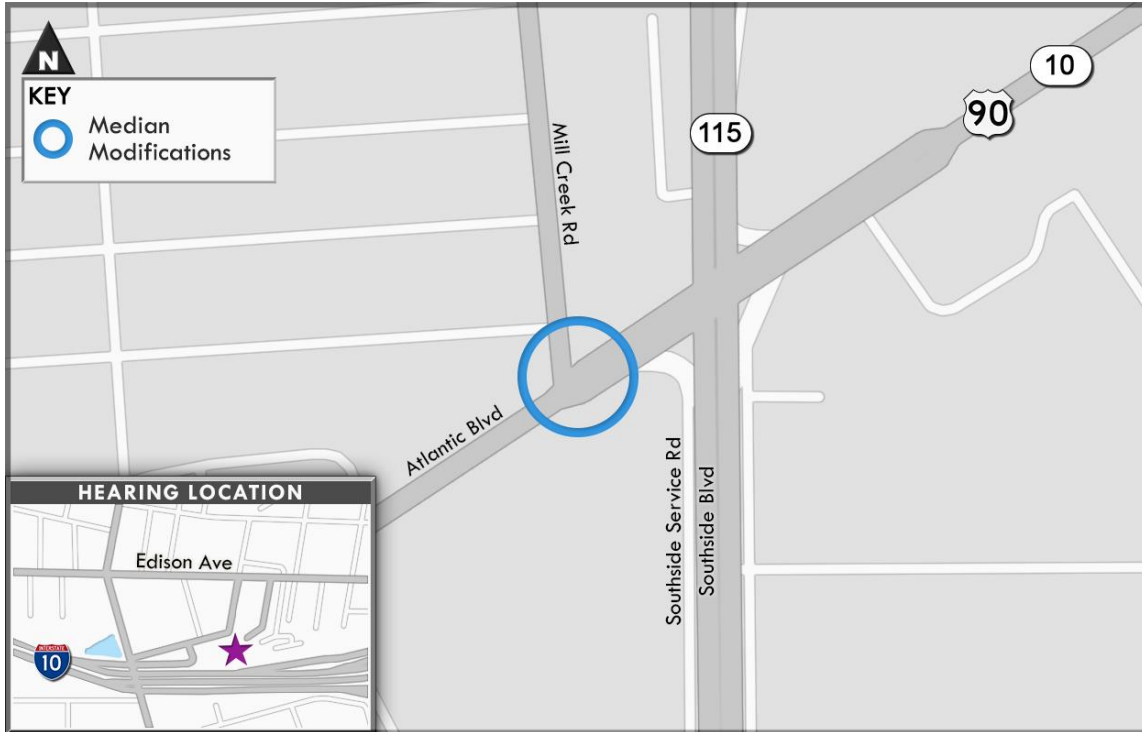
