## FDOT to Host Nov. 6 Public Meeting to Discuss Proposed Changes to Indigo Drive at Emerson Street

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will hold a public meeting Monday, Nov. 6 from 5 to 6 p.m. to discuss proposed changes to Indigo Drive at Emerson Street as part of a project to widen I-95 from Atlantic Boulevard to south of Emerson Street (FIN 432259-2).

FDOT proposes installation of a cul-de-sac where Indigo Drive currently connects to Emerson Street. This change will mitigate a sight distance issue associated with the JEA lift station located at the southwest corner of the Emerson Street/Indigo Drive intersection. Construction of the cul-de-sac is expected to begin in 2024.

The meeting will take place virtually and in-person at the FDOT Jacksonville Urban Office, 2198 Edison Avenue, Jacksonville, FL 32204. Staff and consultants will be available from 5 to 6 p.m. to answer questions and accept comments. A formal presentation and public comment period will begin at 6 p.m. Project documents and virtual participation instructions are available at nflroads.com/VPH. Participants who are unable to attend the webinar virtually or in-person may listen to the meeting by calling (562) 247-8422 and entering access code 464-904-901.

Both virtual and in-person participants will be given equal opportunity to ask questions and make oral statements for the project record. All exhibits or statements postmarked by Nov. 16, 2023 will become part of the public hearing record.
