FDOT to Host Public Meeting Next Week for Proposed Changes to 103rd Street and Old Middleburg Road Intersection

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a public meeting on June 11, to discuss proposed median modifications to 103rd Street (State Road 134) and Old Middleburg Road South.

The meeting will take place virtually and in-person at the **Argyle Branch Jacksonville Public Library** located at **7973 Old Middleburg Road South, Jacksonville, Florida 32222**. FDOT staff and consultants will be available from 4:30 to 6 p.m. to answer questions and accept comments. A formal presentation and public comment period will begin at 6 p.m.
