FDOT to Host Public Meetings to Discuss Proposed Improvements to San Jose Boulevard Bridge Over New Rose Creek

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation will host public meetings next week to discuss proposed improvements to the San Jose Boulevard (State Road 13) bridge over New Rose Creek, located just north of University Boulevard (State Road 109).

A virtual public meeting will be held Monday, July 29, with an open house from 5:30 to 6 p.m. followed by a public comment period at 6 p.m. Interested parties may register to participate and view project information at nflroads.com/VPH.

An in-person public meeting will be held Tuesday, July 30 at the Cuba Hunter Community Center located at 4380 Bedford Road in Jacksonville. An open house will be held from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. where interested parties may view project information, ask questions and discuss proposed changes with members of the project team. A formal presentation and public comment period will begin at 6:30 p.m.

All participants, regardless of the platform they choose, will receive the same information on the proposed project and all comments received in-person, virtually, or electronically will be given equal consideration.
