FDOT to Host Sept. 23 Hybrid Construction Open House for San Jose Boulevard Resurfacing and Interchange Improvements Project

Construction begins Monday on San Jose Boulevard resurfacing and interchange improvements at I-295 and San Jose Boulevard

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – FDOT will host a hybrid construction open house Monday, Sept. 23 to provide information about an upcoming project to resurface San Jose Boulevard (State Road 13) from north of Sunbeam Road to south of I-295 and a companion project that will add capacity to the ramp from San Jose Boulevard to I-295 North. Construction is expected to begin Sept. 23 on both projects.

An in-person construction open house will be held Monday, Sept. 23 at the Jacksonville Public Library South Mandarin Branch, 12125 San Jose Blvd., Jacksonville, FL 32223. Interested parties may stop by anytime between 4:30 and 6 p.m. to view displays and talk to FDOT staff and consultants.

A virtual construction open house will also take place from 4:30 to 6 p.m. Monday, Sept. 23. Interested parties may join any time from 4:30 to 6 p.m. to view displays and ask questions. Registration information is available at nflroads.com/VPH.

Watson Civil Construction was awarded the \$16.8 million contract to complete both projects. Project improvements (FIN 445426-1) consist of milling and resurfacing, base work, drainage improvements, curb and gutters, traffic signals, lighting, highway signing, sidewalks/bicycle path, green-colored pavement markings, ITS and other incidental construction on San Jose Boulevard from south of I-295 to north of Sunbeam Road. The companion project (FIN 437728-4) includes widening and reconstruction of the ramp from San Jose Boulevard to I-295. Completion is estimated in early 2026, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

During the early phases of construction, the speed limit on San Jose Boulevard will be reduced from 45 mph to 35 mph. No lane closures will be allowed from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. seven days a week.
