### **FDOT to Host Sept. 29 Construction Open House for Improvements and Resurfacing on I-95, State Road 16**

**ST. AUGUSTINE, Fla.** – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host a hybrid construction open house for resurfacing and operational improvements set to begin in early October on I-95 and State Road 16.

The hybrid construction open house will be held Wednesday, September 29 from 4 to 6 p.m. Citizens may participate online at [nflroads.com/COH](http://nflroads.com/COH) or by phone at (415) 655-0060, access code 613-141-732. Citizens who are unable to participate virtually may attend the open house in person at the St. Johns County Administrative Auditorium located at 500 San Sebastian View, St. Augustine, FL 32084.

Interested citizens may join the open house anytime between 4 and 6 p.m. to learn more about the project, including construction activities, traffic impacts and other details. Project staff will be available during this time to answer questions. No formal presentation is planned.

Planned improvements include resurfacing a 12-mile stretch of I-95 from State Road 207 to International Golf Parkway, including the interstate entry and exit ramps at State Road 207 and State Road 16. Additionally, a median U-turn intersection will be constructed at the I-95 and State Road 16 interchange. This configuration will eliminate left-turning movements from the main intersection and reduced signal cycle times, resulting in increased safety and efficiency.

Temporary lane closures will be permitted Sunday through Thursday nights from 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Anderson Columbia Co., Inc. was selected to complete the \$30 million improvements by fall 2023, weather and schedule permitting.
