FDOT to host open house for Wonderwood Drive drainage project

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will host an informal construction open house Thursday, August 2 from 4:30-6:30 p.m. at Fort Caroline Baptist Church located at 11428 McCormick Rd, Jacksonville, FL 32225.

The purpose of the open house is to provide the public with details regarding upcoming resurfacing improvements on S.R. 116 (Wonderwood Drive) between Wompi Drive and Gately Road. The \$7.8 million project, awarded to J.B. Coxwell Contracting, Inc., is scheduled to begin early August and is projected for a summer 2019 completion, weather and schedule permitting.

No presentation has been scheduled during the open house. FDOT personnel, engineers and the design team will be available to provide information and answer any questions the public may have. Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, religion, sex, age, national origin, disability or family status as FDOT complies with Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964.
