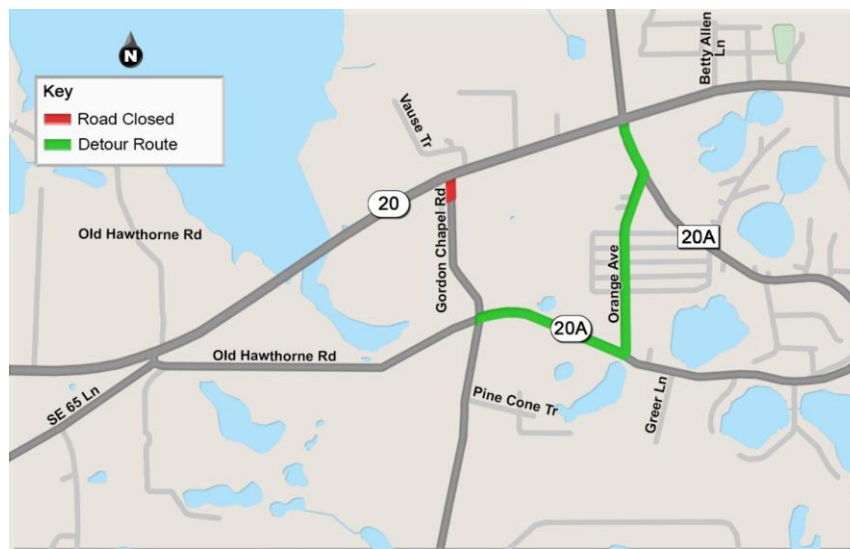
Gordon Chapel Road at State Road 20 to Close for Roadway Work

Hawthorne, Fla. – As part of the widening improvements on State Road 20 from the Putnam County line to SW 56th Avenue, Gordon Chapel Road will be closed to through traffic Monday, January 4 through Friday, January 8, weather and schedule permitting.

Eastbound traffic on State Road 20 will detour to Southeast 65th Street and Old Hawthorne Road. Westbound traffic will detour to State Road 21, south on Orange Avenue and west on Old Hawthorne Road. Northbound Gordon Chapel Road traffic will detour to Old Hawthorne Road and travel north on Orange Avenue and State Road 21.

Anderson Columbia Co. Inc. is estimated to complete the \$49 million improvements by late 2022, weather and schedule permitting.
