I-10 and State Road 121 Operational Improvements to Start Next Week

MACCLENNY, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation's I-10 and State Road 121 Operational Improvements project is expected to start next week, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.

The project includes:

- Milling and resurfacing
- Adding exit lanes from I-10 to State Road 121
- Updating signals
- Upgrading signage and lighting
- Drainage improvements

Traffic will be maintained in accordance with FDOT design standards throughout the project. No lane closures or detours will be allowed between the hours of 6 a.m. and 9 p.m.

FDOT selected J.B. Coxwell Contracting to complete this \$8.82 million project in spring 2025, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
