

### I-295 East Beltway Ramp to Merrill Road Closed Overnight September 2

**JACKSONVILLE, Fla.** – The I-295 northbound off ramp to Merrill Road (State Road 116) will close overnight tonight, September 2, from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., weather or unforeseen circumstances permitting. The closure is needed to allow for overhead sign installation associated with the Southside Connector (State Road 113) resurfacing and improvement project.

I-295 northbound traffic will detour to Merrill Road via Monument Road, Tredinick Parkway and northbound Southside Connector.



Signage will direct motorists through the detour. Motorists on Southside Connector will not be impacted.
