I-295 Ramp Closures Scheduled This Week for Resurfacing

Jacksonville, Fla. – As part of the Florida Department of Transportation’s resurfacing improvements on I-295/State Road 9A from the Trout River Boulevard overpass to east of Biscayne Boulevard overpass, nightly detours will be in place Tuesday, June 25 through Thursday, June 27 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. for milling and paving, weather and schedule permitting.

The I-295 northbound exit and entrance ramps at Duval Road will be closed Tuesday and Wednesday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Motorists wishing to travel northbound on I-295 from Duval Road will detour and continue east on Duval Road and utilize the southbound entrance ramp and exit onto Lem Turner Road to travel back north on I-295.

Motorists traveling northbound I-295 wishing to exit at Duval Road will detour to Lem Turner Road and travel east on Dunn Avenue to return to Duval Road.

The I-295 northbound and southbound Dunn Avenue entrance ramps will be closed Thursday from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Motorists wishing to travel north on I-295 will utilize the northbound entrance ramp at Lem Turner Road.

Motorists traveling westbound on Dunn Avenue wishing to travel south on I-295 will U-turn at the median just west of the southbound ramp loop and utilize the entrance ramp to I-295 south for eastbound Dunn Avenue traffic instead.

Single lane closures will also be in place on I-295 north and south at Dunn Avenue. Drivers are encouraged to adhere to the posted speed limit and proceed with caution while traveling through construction zones.

Duval Asphalt Products Inc. began the \$7.9 million project in May 2018 and are expected to complete it by late fall 2019, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
