I-95 Northbound Traffic Pacing Planned

Jacksonville – The Florida Department of Transportation is initiating a traffic pacing operation on Interstate 95 northbound on Friday, December 15, between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m., weather permitting, as part of the I-95 Overland Bridge Project.

Northbound traffic from north of Baymeadows Road to north of Emerson Street will be impacted. Traffic control officers will be on site at various points to ensure safety of the public.

The operation is necessary to install overhead sign panels. Be prepared to stop during this period.

FDOT strives for safe construction zones. Travelers should stay alert and follow the posted speed limit through the construction zone. Motorists are encouraged to watch for additional signs.
