I-95 North Detours Planned for Next Week at the I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements Project

JACKSONVILLE, Fla. – As part of bridge construction activities for FDOT's I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, overnight detours of I-95 north are scheduled from Monday, March 28 through Thursday, March 31 from 11 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., pending weather and unforeseen circumstances.

Drivers on I-95 north will be detoured to the Acosta Bridge, right on Broad Street and left on Adams Street to reconnect with I-95 north.

FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in summer 2022, weather and unforeseen circumstances permitting.
