New Traffic Pattern Planned for the I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements Project

Jacksonville – As part of the I-10/I-95 Operational Improvements project, motorists on I-10 east will see a new traffic pattern along the inside collector distributor to I-95.

Beginning Saturday, April 18 at 6 a.m. until Monday, May 4 at 6 a.m., motorists traveling on the I-10 east to I-95 inside collector distributor will see a one-quarter of a mile-long traffic shift while crews construct an overhead sign foundation (see below). Drivers may see slower traffic through this area.



FDOT hired Archer Western to complete this \$126 million project in spring 2021, pending weather and unforeseen circumstances.
